No More Victims Valentine's Day Benefit Concert to Raise Awareness About Iraqi Child Victims of War

Mountain View Market's Co-Op Rocks, Best Heard Blind Presenting Benefit Concert for No More Victims

Las Cruces, NM - Best Heard Blind, in association with the Mountain View Market's Co-op Rocks program, will host a Valentine's Day benefit concert for No More Victims, a non-profit organization working to restore health and well-being to victims of war. The event will begin at 6:00 PM February 14 and conclude at midnight, with performances to include 3/5 HUMAN, Shahid Mustafa, Zealots of Anarchy, Starmaggot, The Horror From This House, Kultivation, Finnigan & The No Gooders, comedic stylings of Red and Paz, and more. Cole Miller, founder of No More Victims, and Ann Cothran, National Community Coordinator, will appear as guest speakers.

No More Victims works to obtain medical sponsorships for war-injured Iraqi children, and to forge ties between the children, their families and communities in the United States. The project was developed by Cole Miller of Los Angeles, Founding Director of NoMoreVictims.org (<http://www.nomorevictims.org>), who helps to organize and fund the effort to get medical treatment for Iraqi children in need and their families. These efforts have inspired more than 30 American communities to develop similar projects under the banner of No More Victims. These communities are organizing to provide direct relief to civilians injured by US military operations in Iraq, making their collective efforts part of a larger, emerging story: a growing civil movement of Americans from all walks of life uniting to redress the civilian consequences of the war in Iraq.

Admittance to the benefit concert is free, however a five dollar donation is suggested and appreciated. Best Read Blind will be filming the event for YouTube to further spread awareness about the current situation involving innocent, injured Iraqi children due to collateral damage caused by the explosions and shrapnel from bombs dropped by U.S. armed forces.
